Lesson 49: Quotations

- Quotation – a speaker's or writer's exact words

Quotation Rules

 <u>Dialogue</u> – put quotation marks before and after what someone says. ALWAYS capitalize the first word. <u>Example</u>: Mrs. Wilkie says, "<u>L</u>et's take notes."

2. If Quotation comes at the end of a sentence:

-use a comma BEFORE the quotation -the end punctuation goes INSIDE the quotation mark <u>Example:</u> Angie exclaimed, "I want recess!!"

3. If Quotation comes at the beginning of a sentence:

- Statement or Command

-comma goes INSIDE quotation mark <u>Example</u>: "I'm hungry;" Caielle said. <u>Example</u>: "Then eat your banana;" Tehillah responded.

-Question or Exclamation

-question mark or exclamation goes INSIDE quotation mark

Example: "Who left a mess in my desk?" Brianna asked.

Example: Catherine exclaimed, "There's a banana peel in my desk!)"

4. NOT exact words: (paraphrase)

No quotation marks

Example: Briana said, "I want to eat an apple."

VS.

Briana said that she wants to eat an apple.
